The trainee may join the courses of International Master/PhD program in medicine at school and participate in the patient care at hospitals under the supervision of a mentor.





- 3. Student physical examination report within 3 months (required items; hepatitis B vaccine and chest X-ray are required)
- 4. Application form
- 5. Color photo 2"x 2"(for identification card)
- 6. Photocopy of student ID card
- 7. COVID-19 vaccination record card

 - 1. Application form.
 - 2. Copy of passport and ARC residence permit.
 - 3. Photocopies of foreign medical personnel certificate/license, specialist certificates/license, board certificate and other qualification certificates (including Chinese or English official translations).
 - 4. Documents proving that you have **engaged in medical business** for **more than one year** within the **six months prior to the application date** (including Chinese or English **official** translations).
 - 5. Study/training **proposal** (content should include the purpose of clinical study, start and end time, department, guidance of medical staff, clinical study items).
 - 6. During the training period of more than three months but less than six months, a health examination report (including chest X-ray, syphilis serum test, measles and German measles, etc.) should be provided.
 - 7. Other Chinese or English translation materials.

- ✓ Step 4: wait for approval and then start the clinical training.

WHEN TO TAKE ICTP & FEES

If you are M.D., you can apply for this course when you nearly complete your study at TMU.

We strongly recommend students apply this course in the last semester before your graduation.

Your study progress might be good and therefore your supervisor would be willing to help you to learn more.

If your study progress is good, your supervisors can/will agree to let you take the course early because there is no additional fee for taking the course before the third year.

During and after third year, you have to pay the 2 credit fee in total of NTD\$4000 approx.

IGPM Ph.D. Program Graduation Timeline (3 years)



SUPERVISORS

For the students who's supervisors are not physicians, you still can apply for the course, and your supervisor will help you to arrange an advisor in the hospital to take care of you.

CHINESE COURSE

When you are learning in the hospital, the official language is Chinese.



Your advisor might not have time to translate the conversation between doctors and patients for you.



That means, if you don't know a bit Chinese, you will have difficulty.



We strongly recommend you take the free Chinese course in TMU since the first year, and interact with more local students to improve your Chinese.



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
